Greenville Community Church (GCC) is prayerfully seeking its next Senior Pastor. Interested candidates are encouraged to explore and review all that Greenville Community Church is now and what we are anticipating for God to do through our church in the next 3-5 years.

Overview

Greenville Community Church is in the Wesleyan denomination and has a thriving congregation with an average weekly attendance of 590. Our church was founded as a church plant by Dr. Wayne Otto back in September of 1994. The church started in the basement of a local home in the community and the first worship service had 15 people in attendance. Within four years, the church had grown to 140 people. With the donation of 75 acres of farmland from a local farmer, the church began construction on a permanent place of worship. Greenville Community Church grew in numbers, saw many lives changed through the years, and was projected to have an average weekly attendance of 700 by 2020. Pastor Bryan Savage was our most recent pastor and with God's help, we have experienced growth once again with new families coming back to church each week post COVID-19.

We have added a second church campus that is fully integrated into our mission and vision. Crystal Lake Community Church is led by its campus pastor, Pastor Scott McNett, and many dedicated volunteers.

The congregation of Greenville Community Church has always followed the teachings of God in tithing. Over the past three years, the church has given more than \$60,000 for missions and paid off more than \$600,000 in property debt, putting GCC on a path to be debt-free.

Greenville Community Church is fueled by the mission statement: "Building Hope, Changing Lives." GCC is not a church that needs "fixing", rather it is poised to go to the next level and desires to call a Senior Pastor who will inspire and mobilize the church to achieve even greater effectiveness in the future.

Staff

A key factor in the impressive level of congregational satisfaction and health is credited to the talented and dedicated staff. There is a warm camaraderie and commitment to the ministry by the staff team. While this team brings a strong level of experience, they are also eager to welcome a leader who will bring new ideas. This team has proven to be responsive when the Senior Pastor assesses current reality with fresh eyes and casts a vision for the season ahead. There is a tremendous opportunity for the incoming Senior Pastor to capitalize on this strong pool of leaders to engage their talent and faithfully serve God's people at GCC and beyond.

The staff consists of six full-time leaders. They are Scott McNett, Campus Pastor at Crystal

Lake Church; Alee Lafferty, Executive Assistant; Sarah DeVries, Children's Ministry Director; Nick VanRiper, Student Ministry Director; Lauren Magnuson, Worship Director. They are supported in ministry by a part-time Finance Director, Aimee Davis, in addition to many gifted and talented volunteers. The incoming leader will be able to lead a talented team as a shepherd of a faithful and generous community of believers.

Ministries

Worship and Creative Arts – Led by Lauren Magnuson

The Worship and Creative Arts team uses their talents, passion, compassion, and zeal to create an atmosphere where God can build hope and change lives. GCC offers a creative, diverse, and impactful worship experience – including live and online services each week. The team consistently seeks to honor Jesus and draw participants into the presence of God through excellent worship and engaging media.

Kids Ministry – Led by Sarah DeVries

GCC Kids is designed for kids from birth through 5th grade. Our goal is that every child, parent, and family experiences God, freedom, and life through biblical teaching, invested leaders, fun experiences, parent/family partnerships, and safe environments.

Student Ministry – Led by Nick Van Riper

TRIBE is our student ministry for 6th-12th grade students. TRIBE provides a place for students to belong to something bigger than themselves where they will serve their community, learn to be more like Christ, and have fun playing games and making memories.

Frontline Ministry

Frontline Ministry is made up of volunteers who love to serve others. This team is responsible for greeting every person who comes into Greenville Community Church, answering any questions, and pointing people in the right direction. Frontline Ministry consists of greeters, ushers, café servers, church security, and Welcome Center volunteers.

Love Your Neighbor

Love Your Neighbor is a ministry that builds and changes by loving our neighbors as ourselves. Our Love Your Neighbor Ministry is made up of several teams of volunteers who serve our neighbors in creative ways.
